

#### ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU GLORIA MARIS

Another Community Assessment for Amoma Project

The Rotary Club of Cebu Gloria Maris, in collaboration with Casto Travels CEO, Maryles Casto and her team, along with volunteers from the University of San Carlos College of Nursing, united in a meaningful endeavor. Together, they conducted a community assessment and pre-launch activities for 134 malnourished children residing in the Soong dumpsite in Mactan.

During the assessment, nursing students interviewed parents and children to understand their nutrition habits. Meanwhile, volunteers distributed nutritious meals comprising rice, vegetables, and chicken to the children. They were also given a nutrient-densed choco drink and a proprietary blend of 20 fruits and vegetables.

President Gay Marie Tiu took the initiative to group parents of malnourished children and explained the 3-6 months Balancing Nutrition Program, aiming to address their nutritional needs comprehensively.


