She served a second term as Club President in RY 2013-2014 when the devastating super typhoon Yolanda struck Tacloban City.

Beyond the club, she has generously extended her time and talent to serve in various capacities as Assistant Governor, Deputy District Governor for three consecutive years, District Governor's Representative to the Philippine Rotary Magazine, District Stewardship Subcommittee Chair, District Endowment and Major Gifts Adviser, District Empowering Girls Chair, and as District Executive Secretary.

An avid supporter of The Rotary Foundation since 2006 when she became a Paul Harris Society member prior to becoming a Rotarian, DG Caycay and Spouse Bobby, are Major Donors Level 4 with a named endowment fund.

To date, she has grown her business in the region and operates several restaurants. Her management style has been recognized through the years and has garnered her numerous awards and recognitions.
