#### **SECRETARY'S REPORT**

Jan Ashley "Ashley" E. Morelos

#### **Minutes of April 24 meeting:**

Pres. Alex Pal called the meeting to order at 6:30 a.m.

1) Rtn. Randy Quisil led the invocation.

2) After the singing of the Pambansang Awit, Rtn. Tona Matiao, our oldest Charter Member, recited the Four-Way Test *from memory*.

3) After breakfast, Sec. Ashley Morelos led the group in fellowship singing, with the song titled *Always*.

4) PE Loloy Baylon then shared some Rotary information: He talked

about some initial preparations for the induction ceremony of the 2024-25 officers and directors, including that of the RCDS Anns, headed by Ann Jin Honculada-Genove. He presented the budget of P135,000. He will be presenting the program in our next meeting to show what we can expect during the induction.

5) Pres. Alex Pal introduced the guest speaker, Edward Du, president of the Negros Oriental Chamber of Commerce & Industry.

Also recognized were:Ryan Uy, our baby Rotarian who was attending his third RCDS meeting; and NOCCI secretary Tmae Alvion.

Our office secretary, Jonet, was celebrating her birthday, and we all sang

her a birthday song with a serving of ice cream.

6) Ed Du shared his thoughts about the Negros Island Region, saying that unless President Marcos Jr. will exercise his veto power, he will either sign the NIR Bill, or let it automatically become a law 30 days after it was sent to his office. The first week of May could be the week that the NIR will

either be officially created, or rejected.

The speaker noted the opposition of the Roman Catholic Church which said that the creation of NIR will perpetuate a "system of injustice" in Negros. He said the Bishop may have meant the injustice that began in 1890 when the Island was divided into two provinces not on the basis of language, but on the basis of its geography (mountains and plains). All the mountains were assigned to Negros Oriental, while Negros Occidental kept all the flatlands and fertile farmlands.

He said that under the Bill, Negros Oriental stands to host 16 regional offices, while Negros Occidental would only host 14.

He also said the NIR is not a new concept, having been first discussed in the 1990s during the administration of then President Ramos -- with then Occidental Gov. Daniel Lacson and the late NegOr Gov. Emilio Macias pushing for its creation.

In 2013, political leaders from both Negros provinces again sought to revive the one-island region proposal. Quoting former Occidental Gov. Rafael Coscolluela, the proposal did not take off because Ramos claimed that


the National Economic Development Authority was reluctant to endorse it due to the high cost of setting up government offices in the new region. It was not until 2015 when the NIR was

established through Executive Order No. 183 issued by then President Noynoy Aquino III. Its operation, however, was short-lived because t was abolished by 2017 by former President Duterte through Executive Order No. 38.

7) During the open forum, PADG Alex Amor Jr. informed the group that the Rtn. Martin "Ting" Matiao Foundation was a member of the Technical Working Group that laid the groundwork for the NIR back then, and that the TMF had been supportive of the NIR.

8) SAA Edo Adriano had collected the fines ahead of time so we dispensed with the Fine


With nothing else to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 8:00 am.

#### RCDS PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Te are entering today the month of May, the homestretch of our Rotary Year.

Just as we are grateful to finally end our very productive terms of office, we are also eagerly looking forward to a new Rotary Year under the leadership of PE Loloy Baylon and Sec.-elect JunRex Bungabong.

I won't say here my valedictory just yet, as we still have a major event to hurdle, and that is the Club's participation in the District Convention starting on May 3 in Davao City.

A good number of us Rotarians, and our very supportive Anns, will be travelling to Davao tomorrow Thursday and Friday where we will mainly perform the District signature song Where Hope is Planted, at the request of DG Twinkle Gamboa.

We thank Gov. Chaco Sagarbarria for finally approving our request to use the coaster of the Province to take us to Cebu on May 3, and take us back to Dumaguete on May 6.

I was recently at the Capitol to follow up on our request through Provincial Attorney Arthur Tolcidas -- who was an active member of our Club. The secretary informed me he was having a meeting with several lawyers. Then suddenly, the door opened and out came our very own PP Bimbo Laghit. So I gently reminded him of the pledge made by Cong. Our only expense would be the fuel, the fees for the RORO barge crossing, and the driver's

across the Tañon Strait to Cebu. To my pleasant surprise, Rtn. Wilkie without any hesitation pledged to provide two round-trip Passes for the coaster so it could take us to Cebu on May 3, and return to Cebu and pick us on May 6.

Thank God for generous and supportive Rotarians who come to our aid when we need it most! \*\*\*\*

I would also like to express the Club's collective gratitude to PP Ran Lim and VP Jeorex Chua for spearheading the move to raise funds to take with us to Davao our star singer, Ann Mayette Koerkamp.

In October 2023, Ann Irma and I bought a plane ticket to Davao for Ann Mayette who had been patiently training "RCDS Hope-Creating Chorale" for this song. We didn't realize that time, however, the bigger challenge since she couldn't simply leave behind her two little boys under the care of Rtn. Jobert.

So what PP Ran and VP Jeorex did was genius: Since RCDS has truly been blessed by the talent shared with us by Ann Mayette throughout this Rotary year, they decided to gift the Koerkamps with a trip to join us all in Davao, and we're all the better for it.

Thank you to the other Rotarians who anonymously pitched in to support this hearwarming and noble move.

We look forward to inducting our baby Rotarian, Ryan Uy soon. In our meeting last week, I informed him that the Board has approved his application for membership with RCDS, having consistently attended his third meeting. I have also asked the Rotarians, and have not received any impediments to his membership.

From that time, the Rotary Foundation
has been achieving the noble objective

of furthering "understanding and friendly relations between peoples of different nations". In 1957, the idea of the Paul Harris Fellow recognition was first proposed as a means

to promote voluntary giving to the Rotary

Although the concept of making \$1,000-gifts to the Foundation was slow in developing, by the early 1970s the program began to gain popularity.

The distinctive Paul Harris Fellow medallion, lapel pin, and a certificate have become highly-respected symbols of a substantial commitment to The Rotary Foundation by Rotarians and friends around the world.

#### **Rotary Factoids**

#### THE ROTARY FOUNDATION'S BEGINNING

Some magnificent projects grow from very small seeds. The Rotary Foundation had that sort of modest beginning.

In 1917 RI President Arch Klumph told the delegates to the Atlanta Convention that "it seems eminently proper that we should accept endowments for the purpose of doing good in the world." The response was polite and favorable, but the fund was slow to materialize. A year later the "Rotary Endowment Fund," as it was first labeled, received its first contribution of \$26.50 from the Rotary Club of Kansas City, which was the balance of the Kansas City Convention account following the 1918 annual meeting. Additional small amounts were annually contributed, but after six years it is reported that the endowment fund had only reached \$700. A decade later, The Rotary Foundation was formally established at the 1928 Minneapolis Convention.

In the next four years the Foundation fund grew to \$50,000. In 1937 a \$2 million goal was announced for The Rotary Foundation, but these plans were cut short and abandoned with the outbreak of World War II.

In 1947, upon the death of Paul Harris, a new era opened for the Rotary Foundation as memorial gifts poured in to honor the founder of Rotary. From that time, The Rotary Foundation has been achieving its noble objective of furthering "understanding and friendly relations between peoples of different nations." By 1954 the Foundation received for the first time a half million dollars in contributions in a single year, and in 1965 a million dollars was received.

It is staggering to imagine that from those humble beginnings, The Rotary Foundation is now receiving more than \$85 million each year for educational and humanitarian work around the world.
