Minutes of May 9 Victory Party at Dumaguete Royal Suites Inn

Pres. Alex Pal called the meeting to order at 6:50 p.m.

3) PP Boy Diputado gave the welcome & opening remarks. Then dinner was served
4) After dinner, Pres. Alex and Charter Member PP Henry Sojor awarded Certificates of Commendation to Dir. Ronoel Fungo for a job well done as Dumaguete City chief of police; and to Danford Sy, in behalf of the family of PP Susano "Sano" Sy, who is the main benefactor of the Sustaining Assistance for New Officers (SANO) Fund, through Ann Teena Sy.

5) Ann Sasa Lim gave a brief background on how DG Twinkle Gamboa's District 3860 theme song *Where Hope is Planted* became one of the focus of attention of the Club these past months: The ballad interpretation of the theme song, rendered by soprano Ann Mayette Koerkamp (with the soulful piano accompaniment of Alexis Faye Pal) during the induction ceremonies in June 2023, was highly appreciated by DG Twinkle.

Eventually, nine Rotarians and eight Anns who could travel to Davao also personally sang the District song at the Discon *live* -- again receiving a long standing ovation from DG Twinkle and most other special guests that night.

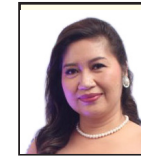
