The wind blew the ashes toward the west so Canlaon City and Negros Oriental was spared from having to deal with the ashfall. Also, the volcano was downgraded from Alert Level 2 to Alert Level 1.

But as a volcano is unpredictable, we do not know if it will erupt again anytime soon. Should a more violent eruption occur, we may need to mobilize our resources from the District to pitch in to the recovery and rehabilitation efforts. Along this line, all our Rotary officers who are in charge of disaster relief operations are prepared for any eventuality. Let's keep praying all will be well.

We welcome Kaveh Shahidi to our meeting this morning. I invited him because he spoke to me once and I was inspired by what he said. He and his wife work with farmers in Valencia and other towns to help them earn more by planting high-value crops in their small farms.

Eleven days more and we will be inducting our new set of officers for RY 2024-2025! If you haven't done so yet, please pay now for our induction. Rotarians are assessed P1,000 and Rotary Anns are assessed P650.
