Dear Fellow Rotarians,

As we continue our journey of service, I'd like to provide an update on our upcoming Medical, Dental, Optical, and Legal Mission in Zamboanguita. Due to a concurrent event by El Shaddai, which requires arrangements of chairs and equipment at the Zamboanguita Gym, our venue has now been moved to the Brgy Maluay Covered Court. Mayor Aviles has ensured a smooth transition, instructing his team to provide us with full support and access to the new location, allowing us to carry out this mission seamlessly.

We are deeply grateful for the commitment of the Barangay Maluay staff, who have dedicated 40 volunteers—10 Barangay Health Workers (BHWs), 10 tanods, and 20 additional personnel. Their involvement, alongside the Rotary Club of Dumaguete South and the Negros Oriental Medical Society (NOMS), will be crucial to making this mission a success. Thank you to Mayor Aviles and the entire Brgy Maluay team for their unwavering support.

In terms of logistics, I've been coordinating with PE Niño Viking for the transportation of our doctors and for lunch arrangements. We have planned a meal costing Php250 per head, covering 50 people with 4 viands, rice, dessert, and soft drinks, totaling Php12,500, and including unlimited brewed coffee. Rtn Randy Quisil is arranging breakfast from Jollibee, worth Php4,500 for 30 people, to be served at 6:00–6:30 AM before the mission begins at 7:00 AM. For our 9:00–9:30 AM snack break, I propose that we each bring individual snacks to share with everyone. Mayor Aviles has graciously donated one lechon, with PP Ely Bodo contributing an additional one. I'll also be bringing viands and snacks to share.

Let's unite with energy, compassion, and the Rotary spirit, ensuring that every patient feels cared for. I look forward to seeing each of you on November 16th as we work together to make a positive impact in the Zamboanguita community.
