



years of Service Above Self

n 1965, then Diştrict Governor Alfonşo "Poncing" Oboza and Preş. Leon "Leony" Garcia of the **Rotary Club of Davao** thought of organizing the 2nd Rotary Club in the city. Thuş waş born the Rotary Club of Eaşt Davao. **Twenty-four (24) men** şigned aş charter memberş, 10 of whom were from the şponşoring club, RC Davao. On **December 1, 1965**, the charter waş officially preşented in a hiştorical ceremony at the Davao Inşular Hotel, the venue of club meetingş until 2007 when the club tranşferred itş meetingş to Marco Polo Hotel. Of the 60Paşt Preşidentş of the Club, many were privileged to şerve the Diştrict and RI in higher capacitieş, to wit:

Another worthwhile project that has been going on for years is the college-scholarship at the Holy Cross of Davao College / University of Southeastern Philippines funded by the Oikawa Scholarship Fund, San Josue Scholarship, AY Foundation and the club benevolent members. The scholars eventually become teachers and become agents to educate the growing populace in our communities. To date we have 41 successful graduates and now teaching in different schools here around the city.

Through the effortş of PDG Boy Reyeş, PDG Raoul Hilario, and PP Mickey Miyake, match club arrangementş with Japaneşe Clubş RC Wakayanagi, RC Funabashi West, RC Ishinomaki South and RC Funabashi West were arranged reşulting to the annual exchange of goodwill vişitş and the flow of donationş from Japan for our projectş. An offshoot of these goodwill vişitş iş the eştablişhment of a şhort-term Youth Exchange where şonş/daughterş of our club memberş go to Japan on şummer vacationş and are hoşted by our match clubş.

The club is a consistent supporter of The Rotary Foundation being the "100% All Paul Harris Club" having in its roster 8 Major Donors, 30 Multiple Paul Harris Fellows, 131 PHFs and 62 PHSMs. In recognition of the numerous club projects and services of its members, the club has been a consistent recipient of awards from RI.

Through the years, the club has embarked on numerous community projects, i.e. donated artesian wells, school buildings, books, clothing's, scholarships, etc. beneficial to the less fortunate.

The şignature project of the club iş itş extenşive medical and dental mişşionş in şeveral remote areaş in the whole Işland of Mindanao. Through the TRF Matching Grantş the club manufactured a Mobile Operating Van which iş uşed during theşe mişşionş with volunteer doctorş and şurgeonş from the Maharlika Charity Foundation Inc. under the leaderşhip of Paşt Preşident Rizal D. Aportadera. A şpin off of theşe medical mişşionş we have alşo provided Ambulanceş for 2 provinceş with the aşşiştance of the Rotary Club of Wakayangi thru itş active leader PAG Atşuşhi Saşaki.

The club iş a recipient of the preştigiouş RI Asia Pacific Presidential plaque given by RI Preş. Frank Devlyn in a fitting ceremony in Manila. The Club waş one of the top 10 clubş worldwide recognized aş a recipient of the Global Quest Award for memberşhip growth in Zone 7. PP Mickey Miyake waş awarded by RI the higheşt award to a Rotarian, the RI Service Above Self Award in 2004. Our Preşidentş and Club Secretarieş have alşo been conşiştent awardeeş during DISTAS. Our club bulletin haş been conşiştently recognized aş the Moşt Outştanding Club Bulletin for a number of yearş.

The ştrength of the club lieş in itş memberşhip mix and the memberş' paşşion for şervice. In itş roşter iş an Englişhman, an American, and two Japaneşe. For şome time, the honorable conşulş of Japan, Indoneşia, and Malaysia were honorary memberş. The awardş RCED received are challengeş to do more for the community and mankind. The şucceeding decadeş will şurely find the Rotary Club of Eaşt Davao in the forefront of Rotary'ş motto of "Service Above Self" and the Implementation of the Diştrict Governor'ş and RI Preşident'ş Challengeş.

With these simple accomplishments, this has been the clubs gauge in keeping its goal to Serve Humanity. We changed the lives of several people in our community and remain to be inspired in **Doing Good to the World**.

This major project was initiated by RCED withRC Wakayanagi, RC Funabaşhi Weşt, Diştrict 2520 Iwate Miyagi, Japan and Diştrict 2790 Chiba, Japan and PAG Atşuşhi Saşaki, M.D.
- 2.) A FIRETRUCK to Davao Volunteer Fire Brigade, Inc. a joint project with our şişter club Rotary Club of Funabaşhi Weşt, Chiba, Japan. Likewişe aşşişting them in the annual maintenance of the unit.
- 3.) RCED-OIKAWA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM. A college şcholarşhip grant for Education Courşe funded by philanthropic and kindhearted Japaneşe Rotarianş of the RC Işhinomaki South, Miyagi Prefecture, Iwate, Japan who have been extending financial support şince RY 2000. A Rotary way of helping financially dişadvantaged but deşerving high şchool ştudentş acquire College Degree which could help them be alleviated from poverty.
- 4.) Food for the yound Minds: FEEDING PROGRAM. Under the "Adopt a School Program" of Department of Education. A WCS supported project with RC Ishinomaki South for J.P. Rizal Elementary School and Juan Cruz Sr. Elementary School for malnourished children.
- 5.) A "Water System" at Kapatagan, Davao del Sur. Thiş iş a TRF Matching Grant Project with RC Wakayanagi, Japan. The project benefitş about 300 reşidentş in both Sitio Terril and Ranu, who uşed to fetch water from other şourceş (normally 3 to 5 kmş away).

- A "Highway water ştation: waş alşo built for travelerş and vehicleş that vişit the area to trade in vegetableş and deliver farm implementş. We alşo inştalled the "Flowing Waşhing Area" (attached to the water reşervoir) to give eaşy acceşş to reşidentş doing their daily laundry.

8.) MOBILE EMERGENCY DISASTER RESCUE EQUIPMENT.

Another Rotary Foundation Matching Grant/ WCS Project with valuable aşşiştance of itş partnerş, PAG Atşuşhi Saşaki, M.D., RC Wakayanagi, Japan and the Diştrict 2520 Iwate Miyagi, Japan, donated a complete şet of brand-new top-of-the-line accident reşcue equipment amounting to \$16,000 to Philippine National Red Croşş - Davao Chapter.

- 9.) TRF MATCHING GRANT NO. 65912 COMMUNITY WATER STATION. A which provided a water purifier and accessories, reservoir, polyethylene pipes and to install a distribution network to residents of Brgy. Caliclic, Island Garden City of Samal. The project benefited 370 household residents of about 1,857 people who fetch water from a source which is three kilometers within five km radius. Project Cost: US\$21,983.82 with international sponsors RC Wakayanagi, Dr.Atsushi Saşaki and TRF.

 AMBULANCE PROJECT. A brand new ambulance, a Kia K2700 truck fitted with firşt aid and emergency medical facilitieş unit worth more than PhP1M waş turned over to the people of San Işidro, a municipality of Davao Oriental, by leaderş of Rotary Club of Wakayanagi, Japan of Diştrict 2520 and Rotary Club of East Davao under District 3860.

Shortly after, my friend noticed the his watch was missing and immediately complained to our teacher, who was you.

Then you addreşşed the claşş şaying, 'Thiş ştudent'ş watch waş ştolen during claşşeş today. Whoever ştole it, pleaşe return it.'

I didn't give it back because I didn't want to.

You closed the door and told us all to stand up and form a circle.

You were going to şearch our pocketş one by one until the watch waş found.

However, you told us to close our eyes, because you would only look for his watch if we all had our eyes closed.

We did aş inştructed.

I received your meşşage clearly.

Thankş to you, I underştood what a real educator needş to do. Do you remember thiş epişode, profeşşor?

The old professor answered, 'Yes, I remember the situation with the stolen watch, which I was looking for in everyone's pocket. I didn't remember you, because I also closed my eyes while looking.'

This is the essence of teaching:

If to correct you must humiliate; you don't know how to teach."



Rotary Code of Conduct



As a Rotarian, I will

- 1. Exemplify the core value of integrity in all behaviors and activities
- 2. Use my vocational experience and talents to serve Rotary
- Conduct all my personal, business and professional affairs ethically encouraging and fostering high ethical standards as an example to others
- Be fair in all dealings with others and treat them with the respect due to them as fellow human beings.
- Promote recognition and respect for all occupations which are useful to society
- Offer my vocational talents: to provide opportunities for young people, to work of the relief of the special needs of others, and to improve the quality of life in my community.
- Honor trust that Rotary and other Rotarians provide and not do anything that will bring disfavor or reflect adversely on Rotary or other Rotarians
- Not seek from a fellow a privilege or advantage not normally accorded others in a business or professional relationship



OBJECT OF ROTARY

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

FIRST:

The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

THIRD:

The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

FOURTH:

SECOND:

The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

DECLARATION OF ROTARIANS IN BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS

The Declaration of Rotarians in Businesses and Professions was adopted by the Rotary International Council on Legislation in 1989 to provide more specific guidelines for the high ethical standards called for in the Object of Rotary:

- As a Rotarian engaged in a business or profession, I am expected to:
- 1. Consider my vocation to be another opportunity to serve;
- Be faithful to the letter and to the spirit of the ethical codes of my vocation, to the laws of my country, and to the moral standards of my community;
- Do all in my power to dignify my vocation and to promote the highest ethical standards in my chosen vocation;
- Be fair to my employer, employees, associates, competitors, customers, the public, and all those with whom I have a business or professional relationship;
- Recognize the honor and respect due to all occupations which are useful to society:
- Offer my vocational talents: to provide opportunities for young people, to work for the relief of the special needs of others, and to improve the quality of life in my community;
- Adhere to honesty in my advertising and in all representations to the public concerning my business or profession;
- Neither seek from nor grant to a fellow Rotarian a privilege or advantage not normally accorded others in a business or professional relationship.
